Frame Strength and Material Quality

Look for: Pressure-treated wood. Yoderbilt greenhouses utilize pressure-treated wood that is resistant to rot and warping, providing stability for decades.

Avoid: Particle board, untreated wood, or thin aluminum that is prone to bending and rusting.

The frame supports everything, from shelving to enduring storms. Weak materials will not withstand wind, water, or the test of time.

High-Performance Glazing

The material used for the walls and roof significantly impacts light transmission, plant health, energy efficiency, and weather resistance.

Look for: 8mm twin-wall polycarbonate with UV protection. Yoderbilt uses this material, which filters and diffuses sunlight, preventing plant burn and promoting even growth.

Avoid: Single-layer acrylic or fragile clear plastic.

Quality glazing offers superior insulation and strength, capable of withstanding high winds, hail, and snow across various climates.



Size and Layout

Your greenhouse should complement your available space and gardening ambitions.

Look for: A variety of size options and models. Yoderbilt provides 10 different sizes across two models, with both 8-foot and 12-foot widths available.

Avoid: One-size-fits-all kits that may not suit your yard or specific goals.

Options for double doors, back doors, or side doors (Traditional Style only) can enhance cross-ventilation and accessibility.

Avoid: Fixed-frame designs that lack airflow or upgrade options.

Good ventilation allows for control over temperature and humidity, and easy access is important for moving carts or large plants.

Ease of Setup and Ongoing Use

Avoid: Complex multi-day assembly kits, unclear instructions, or poor customer service.
